We have recently been issued our performance time for the UIL Region Contest being held on Saturday, October 19th at Little Elm Stadium. Our performance time is at 5:30pm. This can cause some difficulties for students that are planning on attending the Homecoming Dance scheduled for that night. We have contacted our Region Secretary asking if we would be able to move our performance to an earlier time, however we are already near the earliest time of all of the 6A performances that night. In addition, UIL rules mandate that there can be no mixing of band classifications during any UIL activity (mixing 5A bands with 6A bands, etc.) and all 5A bands in the Region perform first. This is not an ideal situation for either of these important events, however we will make the best of it.

Students may be picked up at Little Elm Stadium by their parents or may request to be placed on the bus that leaves directly after their performance. [If you are choosing either of these options, we need to know by Wednesday, October 9th by filling out this Google Form.](#) If a student will be leaving with their parents, they will need to bring their uniform back to school by Monday, October 21st. Uniform will be checked as usual and failure to bring it back properly hanged will result in a demerit. Students not submitting a request by Wednesday, October 9th will be brought back to PHS after everything is loaded.
