Approval of Minutes from January 29, 2020 meeting: Motion – Kelly H., 2nd – Andy T.,

Meeting Facilitator: Brandon H. gave report on successful and emotional trip to Disney World in March over spring break. All the kids enjoyed themselves and did an amazing job. Then Covid-19 struck the US and shutdowns began. It was questionable whether the band would have trouble getting home due to flights being cancelled. Everyone made it home before Disney shut down. School immediately went to online learning platform. Everyone is currently dealing with the news that in person learning is cancelled for the duration of the school year. Graduation and the band's role in the ceremony is unknown.

The Band banquet is cancelled and the money that has already been spent for it has been reallocated for next years banquet.

The idea is to try to establish some version of normalcy for the kids that are impacted by the loss of the remaining school year, especially the seniors. Ideas to proceed with the banquet program were discussed and approved. The focus of the program will be to highlight the seniors. The program will not sell ad space and will cost approx.. \$2500 to print.

Auditions for band placement will be done through google classroom and virtual submissions of videos.

The kids will be notified by google classroom at 9:00 on 4/22/20 of the audition required elements.

The audition videos are due by May 7th. The students/parents will also complete and turn in a form to CHARMS at the same time.

SLT forms and the process will be determined and announced by the end of the week in a band news that will be sent out to all the band and parents.

Concert uniforms that were handed out for All Region need to be cleaned and returned. The directors will organize the process and announce it in band news. Also, school owned instruments will need to be turned in (Srs will be given priority) by 2nd week of May.

The logistics for the Band 101 meeting are still being discussed. Some ideas would be to do a video and put on the website or do a Facebook live presentation.

Work has already begun on next year's show. Music has been chosen and drill has been written. The directors are proceeding as normal. Better to be prepared. Summer band camp is on the calendar for the week of July 27th.

Kevin L., reports that the account is in good shape due to no outlying cost for the past month. The Acct has about \$100,000 which will be necessary for the next year as shortfalls will be expected because of Rockhill opening and the downturn in global circumstances due to Covid-19.

JP W., reported that Rockhill will not be ready for occupancy until July 1st. They will have a very short window of time to move in, set up, and prepare for summer band camp and all the initial set up. The Hawks fight song has been written to the tune of the Univ. of Michigan's fights song. The drill team's entrance music has been written. They are currently working on writing the Alma Mater.

JP has requested a zoom meeting In May to discuss the logistics of setting up Rockhill booster and getting PHS booster board support for establishing the job descriptions for each position served by the board.
